


Formation of the Association

- 2007: Initiated the Sustainable Forest Management (SFM) model in 2 communes/2 districts
- 2010: First FSC® forest certification assessment
- 2014: Establishment the Association of Quang Tri Smallholder Forest Certification Group
- 2021: FSC certification assessment for Non-Timber Forest Products (NTFPs)
- 2022: FSC assessment for ecosystem services (FSC-ES).
- * Forest Area with FSC®-Certification:
- + 2010: **306 ha** managed by **118** households.
- + 2025: 5,619.48 ha managed by 558 households and 5 communities, including:
 - Planted forests: 3,474.63 ha, managed by 558 households/38 sub-groups.
- Natural forests: 2,144.85 ha, managed by 5 communities.




